Provide proof of two MMR vaccinations, after your first birthday, and that are administered at least four weeks apart. In order to complete this requirement, you must submit appropriate documentation to the Center for Health & Counseling.

OR

Complete blood tests to show immunity to MMR. You may visit the Center for Health & Counseling to complete these tests.

As an F1 International Student, you are also required to complete a TB Screening, which may require additional testing. You may also complete this at the Center for Health & Counseling.
