The General Education Certificate of Completion packages all your general education courses into a single certificate that transfers to all public colleges and universities in the state of Utah. Below is a list of all SLCC concurrent enrollment and AP classes that fulfill requirements for the General Education Certificate of Completion. To earn your certificate, **TAKE JUST ONE CLASS IN EACH OF THE CATEGORIES BELOW**. 25% of your classes must be completed through SLCC. You can't earn the certificate with AP classes only.
