FALL 2025 COHORT SELECTIVE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

The following courses and labs (or equivalent transfer credit, AP or CLEP) must be completed by the Nursing Program's application deadlines, no exceptions. Each course and lab must be completed, with a C grade or better. Courses that have not been completed with a C grade or better will not be considered. Course deadlines can be found here.

*Applicants must have a 2.75 or higher overall science GPA for science pre-requisite courses.

Nursing students who have not completed the following support courses by the indicated timeframe with the required grades will not be eligible to advance in the Nursing program. **No Exceptions.**

- PSY 1100 or FHS 1500 (C or better, completed prior to beginning the third semester of the nursing program)
- Pathophysiology NRSG 1230 (C+ or better, completed prior to 2nd semester of Nursing program. If taken before applying to the program, must have been taken within 5 years of application)
- ENGL 1010 (C or better, completed prior to beginning the third semester of the nursing program)

Additional consideration will be given to students who have these courses completed with the required grades at the time of program application.

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT TRANSFER CREDIT

- Transcripts must be sent to the Transfer Evaluation Office by March 15 for fall sessions, August 1 for spring sessions and October 30 for summer sessions. Grades must be posted to the transcripts at the time they are sent to the TEO.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure their transfer credit has been fully transferred to SLCC prior to the deadlines.

Students should declare Health Sciences as their Area of Study and Nursing as the Program
of Study when applying to SLCC. If the program of study does not match the information
submitted on the transfer evaluation request, courses applicable to the program may not be
transferred to SLCC.

VERIFICATION OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION OR EQUIVALENT (GED)

Proof of high school graduation is required to apply. Documentation may include a transcript, diploma or a letter of explanation if you do not have supporting documentation. **You will be required to upload this information as part of your application.**

SITUATIONAL JUDGEMENT TEST (SJT)

A Situational Judgement Test (SJT) will be conducted for top-ranking applicants after the admissions session has closed. The SJT is a proctored online assessment that must be completed within a designated time frame to be eligible to move forward for admissions consideration. Notifications will go out to those eligible to participate within 10 days of the admissions session closing.

PREFERRED BUT NOT REQUIRED

- **CNA LICENSING** Applicants with an active and unencumbered CNA license will receive additional consideration on the application. License must be State of Utah certification.
- OTHER LICENSING IN HEALTH CARE RELATED FIELDS Applicants with an active and unencumbered license in a health care related field will receive additional consideration on the application.
- DIRECT PATIENT CARE EXPERIENCE Applicants that have direct patient care experience beyond 12 months will receive additional consideration on the application. Direct patient care for the purposes of admission would include any direct face-to-face, hands-on care administered to an individual in a healthcare setting. Applicants must submit a signed letter on letterhead by an employer stating job title, how long they held the position and the duties performed while employed. Experience does not need to be current.
- Graduated from an AHEC program

Extra consideration will be given for students with the following:

- ENGL 2010 or ENGL 2100 or HONS 2211 (Must be C grade or better)
- Prior associates and/or bachelor's degree. Degree(s) must be posted on official college transcript.
- Gen Ed Certificate of Completion
- Health Sciences & Clinical related Certificate of Completion
- Verified Veteran's status through the Veteran's Service office.

Any document or information you wish to have considered on your application must be uploaded while completing your application. Additional documentation cannot be considered once you have submitted your application.
