Lineworker Apprenticeship—Licensure Information

The <u>SLCC Lineworker Apprenticeship</u> program is designed to provide related technical instruction for students currently employed in the power transmission and distribution industry.

The Lineworker Apprenticeship program was not designed to lead to state licensure. A few other states have licensure requirements for lineworker apprentices and journeymen. In addition, many employers require applicants to obtain and maintain a Commercial Driver's License. Applicants must be physically capable to safely work in this profession.
