Transition to Teaching, Secondary Teacher APPEL—Licensure Information

UPDATED: 8/6/2024

The <u>SLCC Transition to Teaching, Secondary Teacher</u> program is for teacher candidates with a bachelor's degree in a subject area taught in Utah schools and who are currently teaching in a Utah public school under contract but have not completed a teacher preparation program. To be eligible, teacher candidates must have already received an Associate Educator License through the <u>Utah State Board of Education</u>. Teacher candidates who participate in this program have an APPEL (Alternative Pathway to Professional Educator Licensing) agreement with a Utah school district. It is highly recommended that students consult in advance with the <u>Utah State Board of Education</u> to find out more about eligibility for licensure.

Required Fees (As of 8/6/2024. Fees can change at any time.)

Praxis Exam Fee \$90 (some students take more than one Praxis exam.)

The SLCC Transition to Teaching, Secondary Teacher program is not designed to meet licensure requirements in any state other than Utah.
