PHARMACY TECHNICIAN



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Pharmacy technicians help pharmacists dispense prescription medications to patients and provide information to other health professionals. Pharmacy technicians are needed anywhere medications are used.

The Pharmacy Technician program at Salt Lake Technical College (SLTC) provides the necessary training and externship experiences to prepare students to become licensed as a technician with the Utah Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL).

Classes begin March 6, 2023 at the Jordan Campus. Classes are 15 hours/week, in person 8 hours Monday and Wednesday 9am-1pm, self-study 7 hours/week. 600-hour program completes October 13, 2023. Program includes 200 hour externships in licensed pharmacies.
