## Transfer Information 2024-2025 Catalog Year

Salt Lake Community College Courses	Utah State University Courses
HON 2060 American Identities	3 credits of Elective 2xxx (BSS) <u>and</u> 3 points for Honors introductory experience courses
HON 2211 Honors Writing	3 credits of English 2xxx (CL2) <u>and</u> 3 points for Honors departmental sections
HON 2100 Intellectual Traditions	3 credits of Elective 2xxx (BHU) <u>and</u> 3 points for Honors introductory experience courses
HON 1900 Independent Honors Study	1-3 credits of USU electives <u>and</u> 1-3 Honors points in place of one of the three required courses above (at discretion of SLCC Honors Director)
HON 2900 Special Topics in Honors	1-3 credits of USU electives <u>and</u> 1-3 Honors points in place of one of the three required courses above (at discretion of SLCC Honors Director)

(Note: HON 1900 and HON 2900 are not required SLCC courses, but placeholders for possible future courses)

The University Honors Program at USU and the Honors Program at SLCC agree to the following stipulations for admission to the University Honors Program at USU and eligibility for scholarships from USU Honors. SLCC students intending transfer to the University Honors Program at USU must meet the following criteria and thus earn Honors distinction at SLCC graduation:

- A. Complete an AA/AS degree from SLCC.
- B. Graduate with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- C. Engage in three formal High-Impact Practices (HIPs) as defined in the SLCC Honors Program curriculum.
  1. One will be a strong ePortfolio.
  2. The other two will be chosen from these areas:
    - i. Service-learning
    - ii. Undergraduate Research
    - iii. Writing Intensive Course
    - iv. Study Abroad, a Common Reading experience, or another HIP that approved by the SLCC Honors Program.
- D. Pass all three of the following honors courses:
  1. American Identities (BSS)
  2. Honors Writing (EN/CL2)
  3. Intellectual Traditions (BHU)
- E. Participate in two Enrichment Experiences per semester, in the SLCC Honors Program, and write descriptive/reflective entries about them for inclusion in the ePortfolio.
- F. Students must contact the USU Honors Program and indicate interest prior to USU admission. Apply for admission to Utah State University.
- G. New USU Students must attend, New Transfer Orientation. University Honors Program's Academic Advisor will meet with program students before earning the benefits of early registration.
- H. 9 Honors points toward the required 28 points required to complete the USU Honors Program curriculum. Students will earn an additional 3 honors points at USU (for a total of 12 points) upon completion of all requirements for graduation from the SLCC Honors Program. Upon matriculation at USU, they will be expected to earn the required additional 16 honors points by completing work within the USU Honors Program curriculum.
- I. Students must apply for scholarships, if awarded, remain in good standing at USU to receive the funding.
